Program Introduction

Economics is the study of how consumers, companies and governments together make decisions on resource allocation. The study of economics is central to understanding and analyzing national and international policy-making, financial markets and economic systems.

The Bachelor of Economics is designed for those who wish to pursue careers as analysts, economists, consultants and managers at governmental ministries and private sector organizations.





International Accreditation

Kardan University is the first academic institution in Afghanistan to have received the accredited status from the International Accreditation Council for Business Education (IACBE) based in Kansas, USA. Kardan University has received the IACBE-Accredited status for its business and economics programs.

Program Description

Kardan University's Economics Department is an IACBE-accredited department in Afghanistan fulfilling the international quality assurance standards. The Department of Economics offers an integrated curriculum broadening students' knowledge and skills through core, specializations and general courses.

Specializations

Kardan University offers specializations in Finance and General Economics for students wishing to acquire specialized knowledge and skills in economics.

Students can choose from core, specialization and general courses to complete the 138 credit requirement for graduation with a Bachelor in Economics.



Credit System

Kardan University pursues the international standard, Credit Based System (CBS). Under the CBS, students can select the number of courses based on their specific financial or other preferences.

The BSc program spans 138 credit hours and includes course modules in Economics.
