Second Research Session: Research Paper Writing

The Department of Research and Development (DRD) at Kardan University organized the second session for members of the Research Society, focusing on the topic of "Research Paper Writing." The session aimed to enhance the research capabilities of students and equip them with the skills necessary for effective academic writing.

To lead this session, the DRD invited Dr. Nafay Choudhury, a former faculty member of Kardan University and an expert on Afghanistan's financial and tax systems. Currently serving as an Assistant Professor of Law at the London School of Economics (LSE), Dr. Choudhury has extensive fieldwork experience in Afghanistan, with a focus on market associations and informal legal systems in fragile settings. He has also collaborated with Kardan University on academic and research initiatives.

During the session, Dr. Choudhury delivered a comprehensive and insightful lecture covering key aspects of research paper writing. Topics included the structure of an academic paper, research writing principles, conducting a literature review, formulating research questions and statements, designing research methodology, and presenting results, analysis, and conclusions. He also provided valuable guidance on preparing research papers for publication and stressed the importance of a thorough review of previous research to understand methodologies and build upon existing knowledge.

The session concluded with a lively Question and Answer segment, where students posed thought-provoking questions, and Dr. Choudhury offered clear and detailed responses. Dr. Tufail Ahmad Peerzada, the DRD coordinator, offered closing remarks and expressed gratitude to Dr. Choudhury for delivering a highly engaging and practical session on research paper writing.
