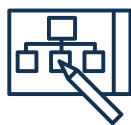

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

This five-week, intensive program helps students learn the fundamentals of English Language for academic purposes. Designed to focus on students' academic learning, this course will help improve writing, speaking, listening and presentation skills.

In order to complete assignments and prepare effective papers, students will have a variety of writing activities to practice what they learn.

The speaking lessons will prepare students to present and speak in front of an audience. They will practice general and public speaking.

The reading part will enable students to improve their comprehension and analytical skills. They will learn how to use reference books, text books, research journals, extracts and other academic resources.

The listening part will help students learn how to take notes, look for main idea of a lecture and improve their listening comprehension.
