

Kardan University Conducts the Strategic Objectives Workshop

The Strategic Objectives Workshop was held at Kardan School of Graduate Studies (KSGS) on December 19-20, 2020. It was attended by 36 participants including the leadership of the University, faculty members, and representatives from all the departments; key stakeholders of the planning process.

The workshop was officially opened by Chief Operating Officer Mr. Mirwais Nahzat welcoming the participants. The workshop opening also involved a brief overview of the Workshop's format, approach, and the desired outcomes of this endeavor. Participants shared and presented before the PTF what they believed to be the most significant challenges and opportunities confronting their departments and the desired changes, and objectives to be achieved by the upcoming five years.

Following the COO's opening remarks and introduction to the workshop's framework, Department Leads individually presented on the broad categories of their SWOT Analysis as findings of the consultation phase with their respective stakeholders/departments/areas of responsibility and shared their proposed Strategic level objectives, actions, and initiatives.

The closing session was chaired by Chancellor Mr. Roeen Rahmani who expressed gratitude for the contributions of the Department Leads as well as the Strategic Planning Taskforce. With a brief remark on the previous strategic planning process, the Chancellor emphasized on aiming towards ambitious goals and thriving to achieving them. These endeavors would be realized through utilizing more operational as well as human resources that lead the institution to growth as the ultimate approach.







The result of the Strategic Planning Workshop is a new strategic plan for Kardan University, but as detailed, it is not an entirely new set of priorities. Rather, Kardan University leaders remain keenly focused on and committed to the core values as well as the programs and services prioritized through the existing strategic plan with a focus on excellence and growth.

We believe the Workshop was an important opportunity to bring the key decisionmakers into a room and engage them in a dialogue that confirmed this consensus on future direction. With the workshop outcomes and feedback received, the Planning Taskforce can now proceed on moving to the next steps of the planning process.

The next step for the PTF is to review the results and fine-tune these objectives. The University has made great strides in the past several years not only in identifying but also acting on its strategic goals. Much has been accomplished, but more challenges and successes lay ahead as we summarize the challenges of progress towards our vision and mission.






He believes that along with his interpersonal skills, and continuous attempts, one of the reasons behind his promotion and becoming a member of University's leadership was his presenting skills.

The main purpose of this party was to create a fun, and joyful environment for employees to boost their morale and appreciate from their excellent performances.

















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
