MBA for Business Graduates

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Duration and Credit Requirements

The Master of Business Administration for Business Graduates may be completed over a minimum 24 months on a full-time basis.

The program implements the Credit Based System requiring the completion of at least 42 credit hours, including the successful completion of a graduate dissertation

MBA for Non-Business Graduates

The MBA for Non-Business Graduates is designed for individuals who have not completed prior education in a business related fields. Students will be required to cover business foundational courses during their first year.

During the second year, students will learn about advanced topics in business, management, economics and related fundamentals.

Duration and Credit Requirements

The Master of Business Administration for Non –Business Graduates may be completed over a minimum of 30 months period. The program implements the Credit Based System requiring the completion of at least 60 credit hours, including the successful completion of graduate dissertation.

Admission Requirements

Kardan MBA admissions are competitive and rigorous. Applicants must meet the following minimum admission criteria:

- Attested bachelor degree from a higher education institution recognized by MoHE.
- A minimum of 2 cumulative grade point average or equivalent in the completed undergraduate program.
- Complete MBA admission application form available on Kardan University's website at the University's admission information offices
- Successful passing of pre-admission Master of Business Administration entrance examination.
- Successful passing of the Kardan MBA interview process conducted after the entry test completion.
- Ministry of Education attested high school certificate
- Tazkira copy and 4 passport size photos
- Completed letter of intent detailing the applicant's educational qualifications, leadership and management experience or potential as well as reason for applying to Kardan MBA.
- Submission of an updated resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- An intermediate level understanding of English Language.

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
