IMPORTANCE OF MIR PROGRAM



ACADEMIC STRUCTURE

The Masters in International Relations program consists of two concentrations Peace Building & Diplomacy and National Security.

The program duration for students with a Bachelor's in IR, Political Science, and Law (specializing in administration and diplomacy) is two years.

However, for those students who come with a Bachelor's degree in other disciplines, the program duration is two and a half years. A set of pre-requisite courses are compulsory for them.

Students from related fields are required to take 42 credits in order to graduate.

MYKARDAN



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission at MIR program is competitive and rigorous. Applicants must meet the following minimum admission requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in International Relations, Political Science or Law (with specialization in Administration and Diplomacy) for two years program.
- Any other field of education for 2.5 years program
- A minimum of 2.0 Cumulative Grade Point Average or equivalent in the completed undergraduate program or at least 65%.
- Passing MIR entry test and the interview.
- An intermediate level understanding of English language.
- Submission of the following documents:
 - o Attested bachelor's degree from a higher education institution recognized by MoHE.
 - o High school certificate attested by the Ministry of Education.
 - o A copy of Tazkira and four passport size photographs.
 - o An updated Curriculum Vitae (CV).





GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Obtaining a minimum of 2.25 CGPA.
- Completing all pre-requisite, core, and specialization courses.
- Successful defense of the final thesis.
