## MIR ACADEMIC STRUCTURE

The Masters in International Relations program consists of two concentrations Peace Building & Diplomacy and National Security.

The program duration for students with a Bachelor's in IR, Political Science, and Law (specializing in administration and diplomacy) is two years.

However, for those students who come with a Bachelor's degree in any other discipline, the program duration is two and a half years. A set of pre-requisite courses will be compulsory for them. Students from related fields are required to take 42 credits in order to graduate.

Assistant Professor, MIR Department




### Mustafa Hakimzada

# **ADMISSION CRITERIA**

#### Interested applicants should meet the following criteria:

- Bachelor's degree in International Relations, Political Science or Law (with specialization in Administration and Diplomacy) for two year program
- Any other field of education for 2.5 years program
- A minimum of 65% or more marks in Bachelor's attested by the Ministry of Higher Education of Afghanistan
- A minimum of second class or B grade for students with Bachelor's from a foreign country
- Acquiring a passing score at the entry test and passing the interview conducted by MIR department



# **ENROLMENT PROCEDURES**

- Online registration through Kardan University website (kardan.edu.af/apply) or visiting one of the Admission Offices
- Providing ID card or passport and two passport size photographs
- Educational documents duly attested by the Ministry of Higher Education and Ministry of Education (Bachelor's degree and high school diploma )

## **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

- Obtaining a minimum of 2.25 CGPA
- · Completing all prerequisite, core and specialization courses
- Successful completion of final project (thesis)
- Financial clearance



#### **Admission Requirements**

The MIR admissions are competitive and rigorous. Applicants must meet the following minimum admission criteria:

- Attested bachelor's degree from a higher education institution recognized by MoHE.
- A minimum of 2.0 CGPA or equivalent in the completed undergraduate program.
- Complete MIR admission application form available on Kardan University's website or the university's admission information offices.
- Successful passing of pre-admission MIR entrance examination.
- Successful passing of the MIR interview process conducted after the entry test completion.
- Ministry of Education attested high school certificate.
- Tazkira copy and 4 passport size photographs.
- Submission of an updated resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- An intermediate level understanding of English Language.


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
