Student Retention Rate	admission divided by total newly enrolled students of Spring 2023 admissions)
Job Placement Rate	J.P.R is the percentage of those graduates placed in jobs out of the total graduates for that particular year. (Placed Graduates of Spring 2023 – Fall 2023 divided by Total Graduates of Spring 2023 –Fall 2023)
Graduate Rate	G.R is the percentage of students who graduated or completed a degree with us out of their total enrollment in 1st semester. (# of students who Graduated in Spring 2023 and Fall 2023 divided by the Total # of the same Terms at the time of admission)
Acceptance to Master's Program	The criteria for A.M.P is CGPA 2.0 which is the minimum eligibility requirement for pursuing a Master's degree in Afghanistan. Students with CGPA of 2.0 and above who graduated from the BBA program at Kardan University, will be eligible students for MBA programs (Spring 2023 and Fall 2023)
