

INTRODUCTION

Kardan University is committed to recognizing students' academic achievements and extracurricular activities, which will motivate and encourage them and other students to work hard towards further accomplishments.

Kardan University is also committed to ensuring no student is left behind from pursuing higher education solely for financial reasons. Every year, Kardan University allocates millions of Afghanis towards scholarships and financial assistance packages for both undergraduate and graduate students.

For the Spring 2021 session, around **25 million AFN** has been committed ensuring effective assistance to the talented students and those students who require financial assistance to continue their education at Kardan University.



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Kardan University's Financial Assistance program is designed to enable eligible existing and prospective students with financial needs to pursue higher education at the University.

The assistance is offered in the form of tuition fee reductions to reduce the financial burden on students. Students who meet the following eligibility criteria are considered for assistance:

Eligibility Criteria for New Students

- Indication of financial need through a purpose statement
- Demonstration of academic, sporting or public service potential and achievements
- Meeting the admission eligibility criteria
- Preferences will be given to those students who fall into bottom 20% of household income group

Eligibility Criteria for Existing Students

- Being registered for a minimum of 17 credits
- Not being penalized due to late fee payment in the previous semester
- Achieving a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Having a minimum attendance of 75%
- Demonstrating community service or research contributions
- Preferences will be given to those students who fall into bottom 20% of household income group



MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIP

The goal of the merit-based scholarship is to recognize and encourage academic excellence among Kardan University's students. The University offers merit-based scholarships to the students registered in graduate and undergraduate programs.

Merit-based scholarships are awarded at the beginning of each semester, and are valid for only one semester. Kardan University students who meet the eligibility criteria are considered for this scholarship.

Eligibility Criteria

- A minimum of 75% attendance in the previous semester
- Attaining a 4.0 GPA in the previous semester, and maintaining a minimum of 3.8 CGPA
- Active participation, and achievements in research, sports or public services



PUBLIC SERVICE, ATHLETIC AND CO-CURRICULAR SCHOLARSHIPS

Kardan University's Public Service, Athletic, or Co-Curricular Scholarships are available to existing and new students with extraordinary achievements in public service, sports, or co-curricular activities.

This scholarship is designed to recognize and promote a culture

of public service and sporting achievement among Kardan University's students.

Public Service, Athletic, or Co-Curricular Scholarships are awarded at the beginning of each semester and are valid for only one semester.

Eligibility Criteria

- Having a minimum of 75% attendance in the previous semester
- Attaining a minimum of 3.0 GPA in the previous semester
- Active membership in a Kardan University student club
- Demonstrating participation in student activities and events



KARDAN UNIVERSITY EQUAL OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

Kardan University's Equal Opportunity Scholarship is intended to extend higher education opportunities to the students from underprivileged and disenfranchised communities.

This scholarship facility stems from Kardan University's commitment to give back to the community and ensures that the university is home to students from diverse socio-economic backgrounds.

Eligibility Criteria

- Demonstrating exceptional academic potential
- Being from a marginalized, disenfranchised, or disadvantaged community
- Students who have demonstrated contribution or intent to contribute to public service or volunteer activities
- Preferences will be given to those students who fall into bottom 20% of household income group

Journalism and Mass Communications

Kardan University offers special financial assistance to spring 2021 applicants who wish to pursue their higher education in Journalism and Mass Communications.

We are committed to offering **4500 AFN** for each male and female student. This financial assistance will be offered per installment and will cover the entire program.



Economics

Kardan University offers special financial assistance to all those applicants who pursue their higher education in the economics program.

2000 AFN will be offered to each male and **3000 AFN** to each female student per installment and will cover the entire program.



Civil Engineering

Kardan University offers special financial assistance package to male and female students who wish to continue their higher education in Civil Engineering.

2000 AFN will be provided to each male and female student per installment during the entire program.
