

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

Introduction

Kardan University is committed to recognizing students' academic achievements and extracurricular activities, which will motivate and encourage these and other students to work hard towards further accomplishments.

These accomplishments are rewarded with different scholarships detailed in the following sections. The university is also committed to ensuring no student is left behind from pursuing higher education solely for financial reasons.

For the year 2020, over 40 million Afghanis is allocated for eligible scholarships and financial assistance applicants across different study programs.





Financial Aid

Kardan University's Financial aid program is designed to enable eligible existing and prospective students with financial needs to pursue higher education at the university.

The assistance is offered in the form of tuition fee reductions to reduce the financial burden on students. Students who meet the following stipulated eligibility criteria are considered for assistance.

Eligibility Criteria for New Students

- Indication of financial need through a purpose statement
- Demonstration of academic, sporting or public service potential and achievements
- Meeting the admission eligibility criteria

Eligibility Criteria for Existing Students

- Being registered for a minimum of 15 credits
- Not being penalized due to late fee payment in the previous semester
- Achieving a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Having a minimum attendance of 75%
- Demonstrating community service or research contributions



Merit-Based Scholarships

The goal of the merit-based scholarship is to recognize and encourage academic excellence among Kardan University students. The university offers merit-based scholarships to students registered in undergraduate programs.

Merit-based scholarships are awarded at the beginning of each semester and are valid for only one semester.

Kardan University students who meet the stipulated eligibility criteria are considered for this scholarship.

Eligibility Criteria

- A minimum of 75% attendance in the previous semester
- Attaining a 4.0 GPA in the previous semester and maintaining a minimum of 3.8 CGPA
- Active participation and achievements in research





Public Service, Athletic and Co-Curricular Scholarships

The Kardan University Public Service, Athletic, or Co-Curricular Scholarships are available to existing and new students with extraordinary achievements in public service, sports, or co-curricular activities.

This scholarship is designed to recognize and promote a culture of public service and sporting achievement among Kardan University students.

Public Service, Athletic, or Co-Curricular Scholarships are awarded at the beginning of each semester and are valid for only one semester.

Eligibility Criteria

- Having a minimum of 75% attendance in the previous semester
- Attaining a minimum of 3.0 GPA in the previous semester
- Active membership in a Kardan University student club
- Demonstrating participation in student activities and events







Kardan University Equal Opportunity Scholarships

The Kardan University Equal Opportunity Scholarship is intended to extend higher education opportunities to students from underprivileged and disenfranchised communities.

This scholarship facility stems from Kardan University's commitment to give back to the community and ensures that the university is home to students from diverse socio-economic backgrounds.

Eligibility Criteria for New Students

- Demonstrating exceptional academic potential
- Being from a marginalized, disenfranchised, or disadvantaged community
